2015-2017 Shirley Recycling Information

For residents living in 1-6 unit homes with municipal trash collection

Single Stream Recycling all recyclables can be mixed, no sorting required

- Newspapers/ inserts
- Office, note and copy paper
- Junk mail, phone books and magazines – Remove cellophane, foil & wrappings.
- Chipboard– Cereal, shoe, cracker boxes, etc., remove plastic liners.
- Corrugated cardboard– Flatten, size to 2' x 2' or smaller and bundle.
- All paper and cardboard must be clean.
- Deposit and non-deposit beverage and aerosol cans, jars and bottles made of glass, metal, or plastic #1-5, & 7
- Food, beverage, soap, and household cleaning containers
- Aluminum foil and trays
- Milk cartons and juice boxes
- Remove and discard caps and rings from all containers. Labels may be left on. Crush plastic bottles.
- Empty aerosol cans.

No foil, wax, cellophane or Styrofoam mixed with cardboard.
No heavy metal (car parts)
No long stringy materials (hoses, wires, cords)

No light bulbs, window glass, dishes, glasses, and Pyrex.
No paint cans, unmarked plastic or Styrofoam packing.

No plastic bags– No Styrofoam of any type is collected with recycling-place with trash.

Note: Think of function (cans, bottles, jars, etc.) and not what the item is made of. Light bulbs, hub caps, plastic toys, etc. are all non recyclable

Regular Trash – Trash is collected every week- Must be in pay to throw Shirley Bags. Materials must fit inside closed bags. Pay to throw bags may be purchased at Town Hall Board of Health Office, Department of Public Works, Lamberts True Value Hardware, M&M Convenience and Roux's Market.

Recycling – Your recyclables are collected every other week

- ♦ All containers should be clean.
- ♦ Remove and discard caps & rings from all containers.
- ♦ Set bins out by 7am clearly separated from trash.
- ♦ Bins containing improper materials will be left behind.
- ♦ Free recycling stickers available at the Town Hall.
